

ATTENTION PARENTS

As of December 1, 2011 we will no longer be handing out Tylenol or Ibuprofen in the school on a regular basis. The use of these medications continues to grow and some students are requesting them on a daily basis. We have looked at other districts in the area, as well as statewide and most are no longer distributing without written documentation from the students health care provider

- If your child has an acute medical condition (such as sore throat or ear ache), a written note signed and dated by the parents will allow school personnel to administer Tylenol or Ibuprofen on a short-term basis – less than 3 days.
- If your child requires the use of Tylenol or Ibuprofen for a period of 3 days or longer a note will be required from the physician or health care provider. This note must also be dated.

Please note that this change is for the safety of the children and our staff. Staff may not be aware of the last dose that was given, or medications that the child may have taken at home. Thank you for helping us in this transition.
