Class Name: **Extended Learning** (Elective)
Length of Class: Semester
Prerequisite: None. (Two of the following criteria must be met: 3.5 GPA,
95 on ITED's, teacher recommendation.)
Grade Level: 9 - 12

Extended Learning will meet once a week. Students will receive 1/4 credit (P/F) per semester. Emphasis will focus on individualized projects, thinking skills, and problem solving. Mock trial and other extended learning opportunities.

Class Name: **Cadet Teaching Work Experience**
Class Length: Semester
Prerequisite: None
Grade Level: 12

The Cadet Teaching Program is a one-semester work-experience program for seniors considering teaching as a profession. The cadet teacher spends one semester working with a high school teacher, for which one credit is earned. Students meet weekly with the cadet teaching coordinator to discuss topics of interest. The coordinator makes an effort to place cadet teachers in a grade level or subject area of their greatest interest.

The students receive many opportunities to observe teaching methods. They assist individual students, work with small groups, correct objective tests, prepare bulletin boards, prepare a segment of a lesson with supervision, construct teaching aids, and read professional literature. It is important to remember that the program is not meant to prepare students to teach, but is designed to help students make wiser career choices. Students interested in the program are encouraged to visit with the program coordinator; they must have the approval of the coordinator before registering.
