

Notice to Students, Employees, and Parents

Early this morning on March 18, 2009, COLO-NESCO High School officials learned of the possibility that a student might have some items in his possession that were illegal. The student was not on school grounds at that time. We immediately contacted the Story County Sheriff's Office. When the student arrived at school, Story County officers detained the student before he entered the building. There were no illegal items on his possession at that time. A search of his car revealed illegal items. Story County officers escorted the student to juvenile detention.

- At no time did the student have anything illegal or dangerous in his possession while attempting to enter the school.
- At no time did he enter the school building.
- At no time were any threats made by students to anyone.

We handled the situation with the safety of our students in mind, and Story County Sheriff officers were involved from the beginning. We took the situation seriously and acted in the best interests of our students and school personnel.
